Driver/Bearer

Job Summary

The Driver/Bearer is accountable to the Manager, Office Services for the effective and efficient provision of delivery, collection and transportation services in order that the Entity achieves its Mission and Vision in a sustainable manner.

Major Responsibilities

1. Annually updates, in conjunction with the Manager, Office Services, own Job Accountability and Performance Targets; ensuring alignment to the Division's Strategic Plan.
2. Develops, in conjunction with the Manager, Office Services, own Individual Development Plan (IDP) following the Performance Review as per the Performance Management System.
3. Dispatches and collects mails as directed.
4. Collects and signs for mail in the Document Centre.
5. Updates Mail collection and distribution Log Book daily.
6. Delivers letters and other articles throughout the Corporate Area as requested.
7. Delivers monthly statutory & non-statutory salary related payments in respect of monthly and fortnightly salaries.
8. Delivers meeting papers and notices to Board Members.
9. Collects stationery, groceries and other supplies as requested.
10. Assists with the moving of Office furniture & equipment, as required.
11. Transports members of staff as directed.
12. Maintains an up-to-date Log of daily activities.
13. Effects minor mechanical repairs and adjustments to vehicle assigned.
14. Checks to ensure that general servicing and repairs are done as required.
15. Ensures that Company Motor Vehicle/ Motorbike assigned is maintained in good roadworthy condition.
16. Exercises the highest level of Integrity and confidentiality in performing duties.
17. Performs such other related tasks, functions or duties as may, from time to time, be assigned by the Manager, Office Services.
