THE INTEGRITY COMMISSION (TOTAL ANNUAL EMOLUMENTS EXEMPT FROM STATUTORY DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS) ORDER, 2023, RESOLUTION

WHEREAS section 39(1) of the Integrity Commission Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act) requires, parliamentarians and public officials to submit to the Director of Information and Complaints of the Integrity Commission, subject to the provisions of the Act, a statutory declaration of assets, liabilities and income in the form set out in the Third Schedule of the Act:

AND WHEREAS section 39(2) of the Act provides that section 39(1) of the Act shall not apply to a public official who is in receipt of total annual emoluments of less than three million five

hundred thousand dollars or such other amount as may be prescribed by the Minister subject to affirmative resolution of the House of Representatives:

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of December, 2023, the Minister made the Integrity Commission (Total Annual Emoluments Exempt from Statutory Declaration Requirements) Order, 2023:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Honourable House as follows:-

- 2. The Integrity Commission (Total Annual Emoluments Exempt from Statutory Declaration Requirements) Order, 2023, which was laid on the table of the House of Representatives on the 19th day of December, 2023, is hereby affirmed.

THE INTEGRITY COMMISSION (TOTAL ANNUAL EMOLUMENTS EXEMPT FROM STATUTORY DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS) ORDER, 2023, RESOLUTION

WHEREAS section 39(1) of the Integrity Commission Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act) requires, parliamentarians and public officials to submit to the Director of Information and Complaints of the Integrity Commission, subject to the provisions of the Act, a statutory declaration of assets, liabilities and income in the form set out in the Third Schedule of the Act:

AND WHEREAS section 39(2) of the Act provides that section 39(1) of the Act shall not apply to a public official who is in receipt of total annual emoluments of less than three million five hundred thousand dollars or such other amount as may be prescribed by the Minister subject to affirmative resolution of the House of Representatives:

2. The Integrity Commission (Total Annual Emoluments Exempt From Statutory Declaration Requirements) Order, 2023, is hereby affirmed.

THE INTEGRITY COMMISSION ACT

THE INTEGRITY COMMISSION (TOTAL ANNUAL EMOLUMENTS EXEMPT FROM STATUTORY DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS) ORDER, 2023

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 39(2) of the Integrity Commission Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Integrity Commission (Total Annual Emoluments Exempt From Statutory Declaration Requirements) Order, 2023.
- 2. Twelve million dollars is the amount hereby prescribed for the purposes of section 39(2) of Act, so that section 39(1) of the Act shall not apply to a public official who is in receipt of total annual emoluments of less than twelve million dollars, and section 39(2) of the Act shall be read and construed accordingly.
