Integrity Commission Administers Anti-Corruption, Good Governance and Integrity Training to fourteen more entities during 2nd Quarter FY 2023-2024

October 24, 2023 – Over the period July 1, 2023 to September 30, 2023, the Integrity Commission, through its Corruption Prevention, Stakeholder Engagement and Anti-Corruption Strategy Division, completed the delivery of its specially developed series of Anti-Corruption, Good Governance and Integrity Sensitization Workshops for select representatives of three Government Ministries, eleven Public Bodies, as well as participants on the Protected Disclosures Training Programme and participants at a Caribbean Regional Drug Law Enforcement Training Centre – REDTRAC Anti-corruption Seminar. The workshop modules were designed by the Commission to cover a wide range of anti-corruption, integrity and good governance subject areas, and also to impart critical information about the Commission's statutory mandates, enforcement functions and Jamaica's anti-corruption laws.

Topics covered included an overview of Jamaica's anti-corruption institutional and legislative frameworks; the problem of corruption, inclusive of the various types of corruption; the costs of corruption; the responsibility of a country's leaders and lawmakers to tackle corruption; and the principles of good governance, integrity, ethical conduct and accountability in public life.
