Integrity Commission Continues its Anti-Corruption, Good Governance and Integrity Training for Jamaica Public Officials – Reports on 2023 1st Quarter Training

June 16, 2023 – Over the period January 1, 2023 to March 31st 2023, the Integrity Commission, through its Corruption Prevention, Stakeholder Engagement and Anti-Corruption Strategy Division, completed the delivery of its specially developed series of Anti-Corruption, Good Governance and Integrity Sensitization Workshops for select representatives of two (2) Ministries of Government and ten (10) Agencies of Government. The workshop modules were designed by the Commission to cover a wide range of anticorruption, integrity and good governance subject areas, and also to impart critical information about the Commission's statutory mandates, enforcement functions and Jamaica's anticorruption laws.

Topics covered include, but are not limited to, an overview of Jamaica's anti-corruption institutional and legislative frameworks; the problem of corruption, inclusive of the various types of corruption; the costs of corruption; the responsibility of a country's leaders and lawmakers to tackle corruption; and the principles of good governance, integrity, ethical conduct and accountability in public life.
